

TEAMS EVENTING CHALLENGE

NED TWOHILL MEMORIAL SHIELD



SUNDAY 19TH JUNE 2011

COMMENCING 8.30AM

Venue: "Beauhaven"

(Cnr) 816 Oxenford-Tamborine Rd & Currey Rd,
Wongawallan (take exit 57 Oxenford / Mt Tamborine Rd,
and follow for approx. 8 kms and turn right into
Currey Rd and take first driveway on right.)



This is a Teams Event designed to bring riders from all three disciplines together. Ned Twohill was Queensland State Chief Instructor for many years. He competed in 3DEs for over 15 years, winning the prestigious Prince Phillip Trophy at the Sydney 3DE. He helped develop a number of eventing courses in Queensland and managed interstate, national and international pony club teams.

Rules:

- Teams of 3 riders made up from riders within their Club or Zone. If not enough riders from your club or zone, a composite team maybe formed with permission of the organisers.
- One rider per phase, i.e. Rider A does the dressage, Rider B the cross country, Rider C the Showjumping.
- Teams must nominate a name e.g.: "The Misfits"
- A rider may have two rides, whether it is on one or two horses, but can only do the same jumping phase once, but the dressage rider may ride two dressage tests.
- A rider may ride in another team for their second ride and may use another horse.
- The horse must not have been ridden by another rider.
- A rider cannot ride below their grading but may ride in the highest grading offered on the day, e.g. elementary dressage horse can compete in Novice. A preliminary dressage rider can ride the novice dressage.
- A horse cannot compete above its grading in the cross country phase. The eventing grade only applies to the cross country phase, so what the card says applies here to the rider doing this leg of the team.
- In Class 1 & 2. Class 3 is that level and above. D grade Showjumpers may compete in class 2 or 3. Official 12 & unders may ride class 1 or 2 Showjumping or Dressage but only class 1 cross country all other 12 & under are class 1 only.
- A graded horse may be ridden by a non-graded rider in a lower level.
- Seniors may form their own team or join a team with junior and associate members in classes 1, 2, or 3. Seniors to be responsible for the level they choose if horse is not registered.

BACK NUMBERS:

Club to collect numbers and leave a refundable deposit of \$10 (please have a envelope with the correct money ready and your Club name on it). Note one back number per team which is worn by the appropriate rider in each phase.

DRESSAGE:

Commencing at 8.30am.

SHOWJUMPING:

Commencing at 10am with Class 1 Beginners.

CROSS COUNTRY

To follow the completion of the Dressage phase.

Penalties will be imposed for riders being under or over the time after 20 seconds has elapsed, 0.4 penalty is applied for every commenced second.

Competitors are permitted to wear a watch.

CAMPING & STABLING

Is available at the Ned Twohill Equestrian Centre, located in Queen Street, Southport (Southport Pony Club grounds). If travelling on the motorway take Exit 62. **Queen Street is now WESTBOUND only.**

FEES: Stable bond \$50.00 per club (refundable upon inspection by stable manager. Note please provide a separate Club cheque for this)

Stable Fee: per stable \$10.00: Camping Fee: per site \$10.00.

VENUE

“Beauhaven” is located on Cnr Currey Road and Oxenford-Tamborine Road, Wongawallan. Take exit 57 off the Motorway and follow the Tamborine Mountain signs. Approximately 8kms from the roundabout at Oxenford.

Cross Country Course: will be open for walking from 3.00pm on Saturday.

Helpful Hints

- If you are walking the cross country course in the morning wear your gumboots as shoes will get wet from the dew.
- At this time of year it can be quite cool in the morning.
- If you can carry drinking water for your horse to the cross country venue do so as it saves walking. However creek water will be available, located at the Stock yards.
- Hosing facilities are available at Stock yards. You may want to bring an antiseptic wash to ensure all grass seeds etc... are removed after your cross country round.
